How 10 Minutes Can Save a Life

Dwell time (or contact time) is the amount of time a surface must remain visibly wet in order to kill pathogenic microorganisms.

- 1. Clean the surface. Remove the soils. You can't disinfect dirt.
- 2. Apply enough disinfectant to the surface so that it can remain visibly wet for ten (10) minutes. Think wet.
- 3. The surface must remain wet and remain undisturbed for ten (10) minutes. If you need to apply more, start the timer over.
